Overview:

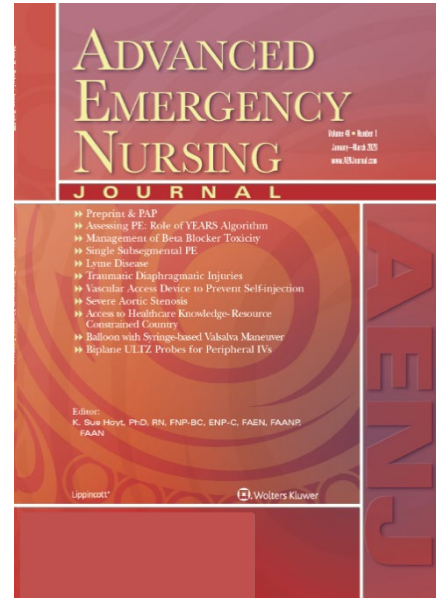

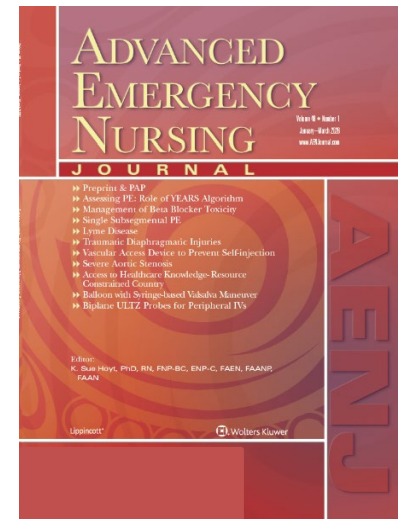


Scope of Work and Deliverables:

- Editorial Leadership
 - Curate and publish high-impact, original content covering priority topics, determine departments, columns, and special issues within defined page budgets
 - Develop and execute a strategic plan for journal growth and improvement, using performance analytics and working in collaboration with the Editorial Board and Publisher
 - Seek out opportunities to increase the journal's visibility, reputation, and professional influence
- Peer Review and Board Leadership
 - Select, manage, and evaluate Editorial Board members and peer reviewers
 - Recruit and retain a robust reviewer pool
 - Cultivate strong relationships with authors, reviewers, and board members to promote an inclusive, supportive editorial environment
 - Evaluate peer reviewer comments for quality and accuracy and determine eligibility for reviewer CE credit
- Operations, Governance and Strategy
 - Render clear and timely manuscript decisions, including constructive feedback to authors when rejections occur
 - Assign final manuscripts to each issue and build balanced issue lineups to meet publication schedules
 - Prepare and present an Annual Editor Report to the Editorial Board at the Editorial Board meetings
 - Identify one article per issue suitable for use as Continuing Education (CE) content and coordinate with publishing staff
- Visibility, Outreach, and Professional Presence
 - Promote the journal at industry and society meetings, workshops, and on social media; seek opportunities to elevate reputation and influence
 - Encourage author-driven promotion and leverage digital platforms to improve visibility
 - Represent the journal nationally and internationally, maintain active memberships in relevant societies and a strong professional network

REQUIREMENTS

1. Doctorate(s) in nursing (PhD preferred)
2. Advanced knowledge of advanced emergency nursing practice or specialty focus area
3. Demonstrated expertise in scholarly publishing, including authorship, editorial work, and manuscript review in leading peer-reviewed nursing or healthcare journals
4. Proven editorial, peer review, and project-management skills, with the ability to oversee complex workflows, delegate efficiently, and manage conflict when needed
5. Experience with or willingness to learn online manuscript systems (e.g., Editorial Manager) and ability to guide authors and reviewers through submission and review process
6. Established professional relationships and leadership presence within national and global nursing or healthcare communities



Interested individuals should submit an application package that includes:

- A current curriculum vitae
- Names and contact information for two references who can attest to their knowledge in the field of advanced emergency care
- A clear motivation and editorial vision for guiding *AENJ* into its next era of growth and impact, included within the CV.
