

Call for Editor-in-Chief – **Lippincott Nursing Open**

Wolters Kluwer is currently inviting nominations and applications for the position of Editor-in-Chief of the newly created gold open access, online-only journal **Lippincott Nursing Open**.

Lippincott Nursing Open will be an internationally peer-reviewed journal dedicated to advancing knowledge across the full spectrum of nursing. The journal will welcome high-quality contributions from all areas of nursing, including but not limited to:

- Clinical nursing practice: Studies and reports that enhance patient care across diverse settings and populations
- Nursing education: Research and innovations in teaching, learning strategies, and curriculum development
- Leadership and management: Insights into healthcare leadership, policy, and organizational practices
- Community and public health nursing: Work addressing population health, health promotion, and disease prevention
- Advanced practice nursing: Evidence supporting advanced roles, including nurse practitioners and clinical specialists
- Interprofessional collaboration: Research promoting teamwork and integrated care models
- Ethics and professional issues: Discussions on ethical challenges, cultural competence, and workforce development
- Technology and informatics: Applications of digital health, telemedicine, and data analytics in nursing care

The journal will aim to serve as a comprehensive platform that drives evidence-based practice and professional development in nursing and healthcare. **Lippincott Nursing Open** will vigorously maintain high publishing standards with careful and high-quality editorial oversight and peer review. The **Lippincott Nursing Open** review process will emphasize the scientific, technical and ethical validity of submissions. Novelty or potential for impact will not be considered during the manuscript's evaluation or adjudication.



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The Editor-in-Chief is responsible for the overall leadership of the journal and for ensuring the accuracy, validity, and credibility of the journal's content. Candidates must be an acknowledged expert within the nursing field, a member of leading professional societies within the field, and have considerable authoring and editing experience in prominent, peer-reviewed journals. Candidates must have a minimum of a master's degree in nursing or health related field; however, a DNP or PhD is preferred. At least eight years in nursing practice is required. Ideally, candidates will have a good understanding of open access publishing. Candidates must possess excellent communication, organizational, interpersonal, and time-management skills, as well as a wide network of professional contacts.

Job description

- Provide a strong editorial vision representative of the goals of the journal.
- Select, lead, and manage an esteemed international Editorial Board and pool of peer reviewers whose knowledge base represents the topics covered in the editorial mission of the journal.
- Actively solicit submissions that align with the journal mission.
- Facilitate manuscript transfers from other Lippincott nursing journals, as appropriate.
- Ensure proper manuscript flow to guarantee timely publication, soliciting content and/or editorials as appropriate.
- Together with the publisher, develop strategies to obtain high-quality open access content.
- Make final accept/reject decisions on submitted manuscripts.
- Champion the journal at professional meetings, workshops, and other appropriate forums.

We would request the Editor-In-Chief commit to a 3-year term, commencing September 1, 2026. Compensation will be provided for the selected editor's work on the journal.
